## Executive Director of Secondary Academies at Lorain High School Announced

**June 6, 2018-** It is with excitement, Lorain City Schools announces that after more than a decade away, Cleveland native Daniel L. Garvey will return to northeast Ohio to assume the role of Executive Director of Secondary Academies.

Most recently, Garvey served as the General Director of Schools for Universidad Central del Este (UCE), in San Pedro de Macorís, Dominican Republic. During his tenure as General Director, Garvey's work included drafting a petition for accreditation candidacy, and in January 2016, UCE achieved international accreditation status. In this role, Garvey led two bilingual K-12 schools, facilitated an international professional development program and taught education courses for aspiring educators. As General Director, Garvey also created a successful, distributive leadership organizational structure while mentoring teacher-leaders. Innovative programming was introduced to UCE's curriculum, by Garvey, which included robotics, graphic design and personal finance courses.

As Executive Director of Secondary Academies, Garvey will oversee seven theme-based academies designed to harvest successful futures for each scholar in grades 9-12. Each academy model is formulated to hook scholars' motivation to learn and sustain their energy to persevere.

Garvey is fluent in English and Spanish, and his bilingual skill set will be an integral part in the district's commitment to fulfilling the Lorain Promise. "As a current school administrator with diverse experiences in U.S. education and internationally, I am passionate about leading responsibly within an international environment, embracing multiculturalism and engaging stakeholders to solve problems," Garvey said.

Garvey's belief in every scholar being given the opportunity for success aligns with the district's five core commitments and the new Lorain High School model designed to assure each and every scholar receives an associate's degree, an additional credential and/or real world experience.
