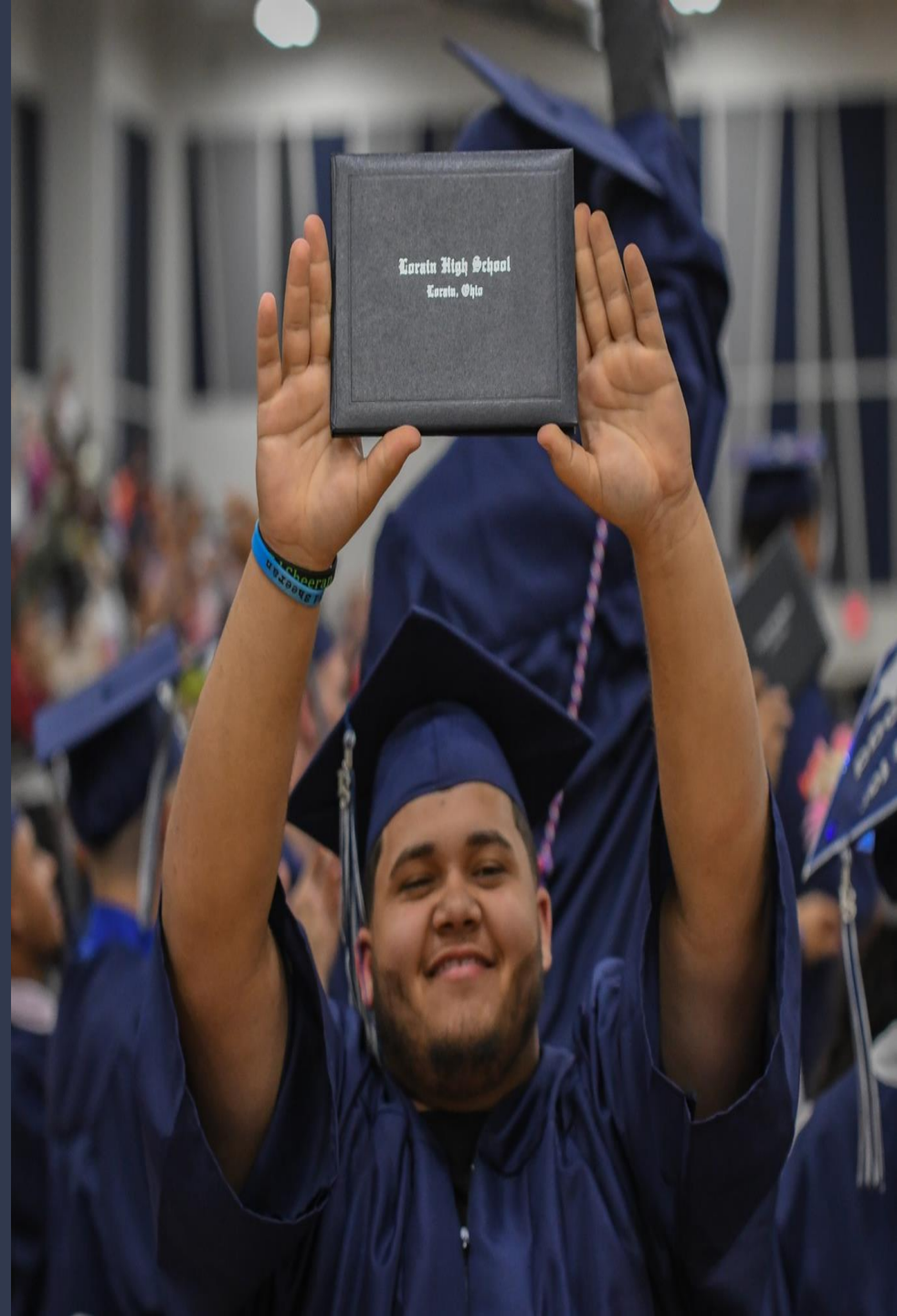

# GRADUATION MEETINGS

## High School Team

Leadership team and counselors met weekly to discuss student progress.

- Individualized plan created for each student
- Weekly progress monitoring
- Collaboration with Graduation Guardians

## District Team

Central Office and LHS Leadership team

- Met bi-weekly to discuss progress
- Determine impact on the State Report Card





# State Report Card

The High School Graduation rate has a direct effect on the district report card:

## Graduation Rate

The Graduation Rate component looks at the percent of students who are successfully finishing high school with a diploma in four or five years.

**Concentrators:** Students who are in a two-year CTE program

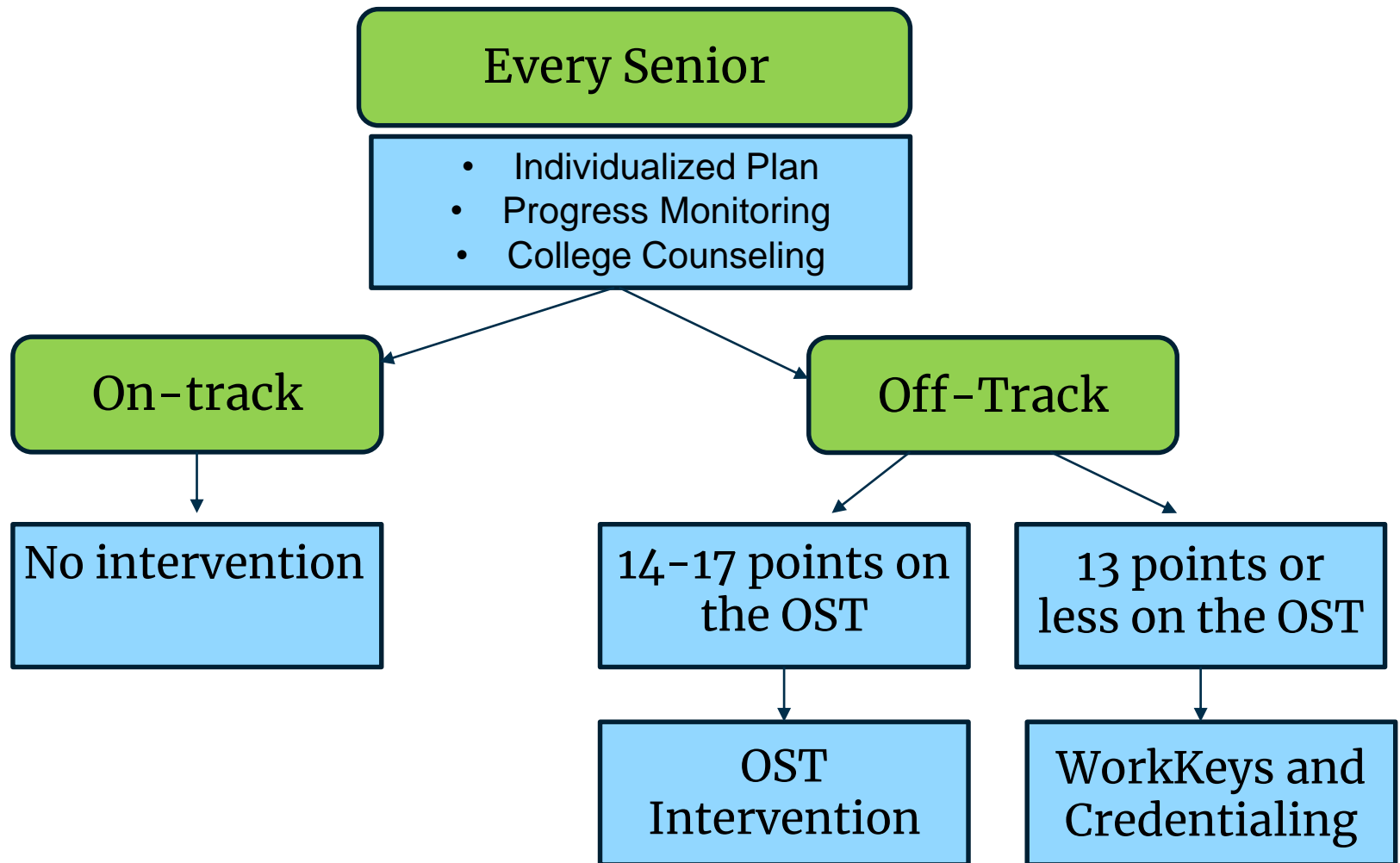
**Senior-only Option:** Student who needs a credential for graduation pathway
