Dear Titan Community,

Beginning April 4 2019, Lorain City Schools parents/guardians will be notified that their child has been marked absent from school within 2 hours of their school's start time. In compliance with the [Ohio Alianna Alert Law](#) the district will be adjusting our existing ROBO-CALL system to send out a call alerting parents of a child's absence within this required timeframe. Our system will begin the ROBO-CALL process approximately 90 minutes after the school start time and calls take about 20-30 minutes to be placed. Calls go out automatically so if you call the attendance line or drop your child off after the computer system cut-off time you may receive a message stating your child is not in school or has not been excused. We also want to stress the importance of parents notifying their child's school when there is an absence as well as the responsibility of the school to notify parents that the child is absent. Our hearts go out to the DeFreeze family and the district will do all it can to put the safety of our scholars first.
