Project Summary	Does not clearly articulate the need, innovation, description and impact of the project. The reviewer has little idea of what this project is about.	Conveys the general idea of the project but doesn't provide enough clarity. Leaves the reviewer with unanswered questions.	Clear summary of the project including the need, innovation, description, and impact. The reviewer has no doubt about what this project is to accomplish.
Background/Need	Data to demonstrate need is missing. What is provided doesn't convince the reviewer of the need for the project.	An adequate description of need with limited data is provided.	Need is clearly described and data provided strongly support the need.
Innovation	The project relies on existing models, methods or ideas; it is not new or unique.	The project will implement some new ideas or improvements but generally aligns to conventional methods. Shows a tentative attempt to step outside conventions or finds new uses for common materials.	Is new, unique and surprising. Has the potential to successfully break conventions or use common materials in new, clever or surprising ways.
Project Description	The project description lacks sufficient details. The reviewer is not confident the project implementation will address the need and make an impact.	The reviewer has an adequate understanding of the project. The relationship between the need, project implementation and impact is evident.	Project is well-conceived and planned. The reviewer has a complete and clear understanding of the project, including the relationship between the need, project implementation and impact.
Impact	The impact of the project is vague and not measurable. The relationship between KPIs/goals and project activities is unclear.	The project is generally aligned to the district's KPIs or contains measurable goals that are generally connected to project activities.	Is clearly aligned to the district's KPIs or contains measurable goals that are strongly connected to project activities.
Budget	Description of how funds will be used is vague and poorly justified. How items to be purchased will contribute to project success is unclear.	The description of the use of funds is generally complete but is missing some details. Items appear to support the project and are likely to contribute to its successful implementation	Use of funds is clearly detailed. Items to be purchased are appropriate to support this project and will contribute to successful implementation.
