Turnaround Principal:

Chantelle C. Lewis has been a public servant for 20 years. In 2006, she was appointed to serve on the Ohio Department of Education Financial Planning and Supervision Committee. As an advocate for educational reform, Chantelle was elected as the Vice President of East Cleveland City Schools in 2007. In the 11th Congressional District, Chantelle was selected as an alternate delegate for former President Barack Obama in the 2008 Democratic National Convention. As an educator, Chantelle taught and served as an administrator in Cleveland Municipal School District and Lorain City School District. In 2015, under her leadership Larkmoor School received the Ohio Department of Education Momentum Award, which recognizes schools for exceeding student growth for the year. Chantelle graduated from the University of Akron with a Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education. She has obtained two Masters Degrees in Education, before the age of 30 and has three licensures in education.

In addition to being an active political member, Chantelle is also a member and former officer of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. She was published in the Who's Who among America's Teachers, Who's Who in Black Cleveland and Cambridge Who's Who among Executives and Professionals. Additionally, Chantelle C. Dean of Academics:

Mary Adamo will be the Dean of Academic Outcomes for Larkmoor Elementary School next year. She has been in education for 22 years and received a Bachelor of Arts in Elementary Education from John Carroll University.
